3. What are some examples of virtues that the author thinks reading can help you cultivate? Do you agree or disagree? (3-4 sentences)
4. According to the author, how do the stories we read impart virtue to the reader? What are some of the examples she gives? (3-4 sentences)
5. How does the author define humility? How can reading literature help us to grow in humility? (2-3 sentences)
6. What does the author say it takes to read well? What can you do to become a better reader of literature? (2-3 sentences)
