Worldview Analysis Assignment

IN A GALAXY FAR, FAR AWAY...

For this assignment, you and two/three other classmates will work together to analyze the worldview in one of the original Star Wars movies (*A New Hope*, *The Empire Strikes Back*, or *The Return of the Jedi*). On [date] you will present your findings to the class in the form of a PowerPoint. Use the skills that you have learned this semester to observe and analyze the worldview present in the movie. Your presentation must be at least five minutes long, and show a good depth of understanding of your movie's worldview.

Some questions to consider:

- Do you see any hints of God's ultimate story (good beginning, fall/brokenness, salvation/redemption, good ending/new world) through the plot line?
- Does it remind you of any Bible stories?
- Do the characters believe in a God, gods, or an ultimate power?
- What motivates the characters? Why do they act in the way that they do?
- Do they have a sense of right and wrong? If so, where does it come from?
- Do you see any significant character development? (i.e. redemption, brokenness, maturity, etc.)

These questions are to help you brainstorm, so you do not have to answer all of them. You will be graded on the quality of content in your presentation, so be sure that you have plenty of good thoughts to share.
